Participation in the Kansas Public Employees Retirement System (KPERs) is mandatory after a maximum of a one-year waiting period or on 7/1/09, whichever comes first. If you have been employed in a position which was covered by KPERs and you have not withdrawn your contributions, you will begin participation immediately.

Your eligibility for immediate participation in the retirement plan depends upon your prior work history.
