Subject: Increases in Student Hourly Wages

With funds from the FY 2009 block grant and tuition maintenance funding, schools/departments have been allocated a 3.5 % increase to improve student hourly wages. With the pay period beginning July 27, 2008, the on-campus minimum wage for student hourly employees will increase from \$7.25 to \$7.50 per hour, representing a 3.45% increase.

The supplemental allocation to your unit is intended for the purpose of increasing the hourly rates paid to students in your area. Students paid from restricted fees, grants, housing, parking and other funds must have the same minimum rate as students paid from general-use sources.

You are also encouraged to consider what other hourly rate increases may be appropriate. For example, if you have student hourly employees who are being paid between \$7.50 and \$9.00 hourly, you may wish to consider if a larger increase is warranted. Units should make the determination of individual increases beyond the newly required minimum rate of \$7.50 hourly.

Further instructions concerning the process of implementing the increases in the HR/Pay system will be sent to departmental Personnel Related Staff. We will use the same automated load process as in past years so units will not have to submit payroll forms for this increase.
